Festival of Trees (Helen, Nov. 9 - Dec. 10)



Head to North Georgia's **Unicoi Lodge and Conference Center** where you can see numerous trees and wreaths decorated in the spirit of the season. The annual event lasts several weekends, during which the nearby towns of **Helen** and **Cleveland** celebrate their annual **Christmas parade** (**Dec. 10, 2016**). This year's **Festival of Trees** will run **Nov. 9, 2016, through Dec. 10, 2016**.

Festival of Trees (*Macon, Nov. 10 - Jan. 5*)



This extraordinary Christmastime display features decorated trees complete with an **evening of gala fun** (**Nov. 10**) all in support of the **Museum of Arts and Sciences**. The **Festival of Trees** is complemented by a children's day at the museum, which features holiday movies, hot cocoa, Santa's Secret Shop and more. This year's event will held **Nov. 10, 2016, through Jan. 15, 2017**, and features more than 40 trees.
