The QuickTrekker is touted to be one of the safest harness system in the industry, ensuring guests are securely connected to lines throughout their canopy adventure, rather than transferring connections. While on the attraction, adventurers enjoy panoramic views of the parks' beautiful greenery, as well as the surrounding lakes and mountains. They might even have the rare opportunity to spot bald eagles, red tailed hawks and deer.

Amicalola Falls State Park & Lodge features 57 lodge rooms and is steps from the popular Amicalola Falls and hiking trails. Guests looking for a more rustic experience can enjoy the park's 24 campsites with comfort accommodations, or stay in one of 14 cabins. Each cabin is equipped with a full kitchen, heating and air conditioning, decks, fireplaces and satellite TV, and are available in one- to three-bedroom arrangements.
